### **DRESS GUIDELINES**

*We at Connections recognize that our school is a place to learn. These Dress Guidelines are created to support the learning process. The intent is to encourage attention to learning, and to support an environment where learning is not being disrupted or hindered by a student's clothing.*

*For the purpose of these Guidelines, "appropriate" is defined as "not offensive nor creating a disturbance, distraction or hinderence to learning".*

#### ***Appropriate Attire:***

- *Midriff, back, torso should be covered entirely.*
- *Garments should have straps and/or sleeves.*
- *Undergarments should not be visible.*
- *Shorts, skirts and dresses should be an appropriate length.*
- *Garments should not display illegal, lewd or otherwise inappropriate graphics or words.*
- *Student's face must be visible.*
- *Appropriate footwear required.*

***If a student is determined by staff to be wearing something that is inappropriate, the protocol is as follows:***

- *Student will be sent to the office to call parent and have appropriate clothes brought to the school. A log will be kept in the office for such incidents. Student refusal may be determined to be insubordination, and may result in suspension as provided in the Discipline Policy.*
- *If no one is available to provide appropriate clothing, the teacher will determine if student will be allowed back to class, and parent will be notified of the incident. School-issued t shirt may be provided.*
- *Subsequent incidents may be determined to be insubordination, and may result in suspension as provided in the Discipline Policy.*

***The expectation is that all students, staff and families will support and abide by these Guidelines whenever they are on campus or at a school function.***
