AHERA MANAGEMENT PLAN

Dear Families and Staff:

In 1986, Congress passed the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Repines Act (AHERA). Under this act, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency mandated the Asbestos-Containing-Materials in Schools rule, 40 CFR Part 763, which requires all schools with any grade between K and 12 to be inspected by AHERA accredited inspectors and to identify all asbestos-containing building materials. This rule further requires the development of a management plan by an AHERA accredited management planner that is based on the findings of the inspection. The management plan outlines our intent in controlling the potential for exposure to asbestos fibers in our school.

Inspection of our school has been conducted. Our architects certified that no asbestos containing materials were used therefore no asbestos containing materials were identified. We continue to be alert to ensure that suspected asbestos-containing materials do not pose a hazard to our students and staff.

A management plan was drafted based on our study of asbestos containing materials and submitted to the State Public Charter School office and is available for your review without cost or restriction.
